Just two more important things to know:

## 1. Legacy device Sign-In method

Some devices are unable to display a second screen prompting you to enter the OTP, but Two-Step Verification will still be required. Here's how it will work:

1. Sign in with your password. An error message will occur.

 An OTP will be sent to your preferred phone. You may also use an authenticator app.  Add ("append") the OTP to the end of your password, and click "Sign-In" again.

You will then be signed in to your Amazon account.

## 2. Suppress OTP challenge during Sign-In

You may suppress future OTP challenges by selecting "Don't require OTP on this browser". As long as the OTP suppression cookie is present, a Sign-In from that browser or application will only require a password. (Note: This option is enabled separately for each browser that you use.)
