I have successfully configured a R6220 router for my home network. Internet on the WAN port works fine, the router has a static IP address (so I can specify a default route for my Linux server), and I have wireless working.

Sometimes I want to log into the router as admin and see what devices are connected. They all show up, but two devices have static IP addresses, so their names appear as "unknown." (My PC also has a static address, but its name shows up as well.)

how can I get names to show up as well as the addresses? In particular, I have a Netgear Ethernet/wireless bridge that shows up only as an address, and my Linux server does the same.

I tried the Address Reservation screen in the router, but my static addresses are below the dynamic range, and the router won't let me specify them.

Is my only solution to set the dynamic address range wider to include my static IP devices, then specify those in Address Reservation? I was hoping for a way to keep dynamic separate from my static range, but have a "lookup table" the router would use to display the static device names instead of "unknown."

Thanks for all information and advice.
